The New Zealand Breast Cancer Foundation is a non-government funded charitable trust promoting awareness of breast cancer. They provide information and education, and raise funds to support breast cancer related initiatives including research, scholarships, medical grants, community education and a breast cancer patient register.

Each year more than **2,400 New Zealand women** and approximately **20 men** are diagnosed with breast cancer. The risk of a woman developing breast cancer is 1 in 9. For every woman diagnosed there are husbands, partners, children, siblings, family, friends and colleagues who will feel the impact of her diagnosis. It is a disease which will touch nearly all New Zealanders and one which we all need to do something about!

Your support helps to save lives through the funding of radiation therapy, mammography scholarships and vital diagnostic equipment for breast health clinics as well as community care and rehabilitation programmes.
