



SMOG PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Players must comply with the principles of good ethical practice listed below. These must be adhered to whenever you are representing SMOG, either at the courts, training or at functions.

1. Behave in a sporting manner at all times to other players, officials, coaches and spectators.
2. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion
3. Don't make detrimental statements in respect of the performance of any match officials
4. Play by the rules at all times and ensure that SMOG is not brought into disrepute by your actions
5. Refrain from using obscene, offensive or insulting language or gestures which may insult other players, officials or spectators
6. Operate within the rules of netball including national and international guidelines which govern NNZ, Netball Wellington Region and Netball Wellington Centre
7. Uphold and respect NNZ Smokefree policy while representing SMOG at matches
8. Be a positive role model
9. Respect the time and effort coaches put into developing training sessions. Ensure punctual attendance and inform your coach of any injuries or illnesses as soon as possible.
10. Play your part in maintaining a professional image for SMOG. Display good sportsmanship at all times by following the rules of the game and avoiding words or actions that are antagonistic or argumentative.
11. Be positive to all club members and be prepared to accept constructive criticism.
